

APPROVED DOCUMENTS FOR BUILDING REGULATIONS

The Department for Communities and Local Government publishes guidance called 'Approved Documents' on ways to meet building regulations.

Building regulations are minimum standards for design, construction and alterations to virtually every building. The <u>Building Regulations 2010</u> cover the construction and extension of buildings and are supported by <u>Approved Documents</u> which set out detailed practical guidance on compliance.

These contain:
